The Battalion and its Assistance Center are on the list of Veterans' organizations which the Calabash Elks' VAC has supported multiple times over the past few years.

The Mission of the Warrior Transition Battalion (WTB) at Fort Bragg is to provide all wounded, ill, and injured Soldiers, and their families, with Physical, - Emotional, and – Spiritual healing services, as they make their transition either back to Military Service, or to separate from Service and return to civilian life as productive Veterans.

The Gift Cards are especially valuable to the Battalion's Assistance Center, because they allow them to purchase necessities and miscellaneous operational Items for the soldiers, or the families, which are not funded through normal appropriations, and they would otherwise not be able to obtain.
