The Veteran's Affairs Committee (VAC) of the Calabash Elks Lodge ~ 2679, and a Corporate Partner, Wyndham Vacation Resorts "Towers on the Grove" of North Myrtle Beach, SC, together, recently made cash donations to the "Good Shepard Center" located in Wilmington, NC. The VAC donated \$500.00, and Wyndham donated \$750.00. The funds are earmarked for their SGT Eugene Ashley Memorial Center, which provides Transitional Residence and Recovery Programs for homeless veterans.

The mission of Good Shepherd Center is to feed the hungry, shelter the homeless, and foster transition to permanent housing. The Ashley Memorial Center was specifically established to provide homeless Veterans with a safe place to live, grow, and become empowered as they make the transition to sober living and economic self-reliance. Since its inception in 2001, the Ashley Center program has succeeded in returning 92% of participating Veterans to permanent housing. Over 55 men have graduated from the program to date.
